MYANMAR WORLD CUP USA TOURNAMENT
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Ni a ciangtan ni dong hong ki-ap team lo ngal ki sanbeh lo ding hi.
 - Any teams that are not registered by the deadline will not be allowed to register for the tournament moving forward.
2. Lutman leh deposit piak kim hamtang ding ahi hi.
 - The entry fee and deposit must be paid in full.
3. Opening Ceremony ah team members teng ki helkim ding, mi kim lo hi cih a ki muh leh \$50 ki liausak ding hi.
 - Every team and players **MUST BE** present at the opening ceremony. Failure to arrive by the start of the opening ceremony will result in a \$50 fine.
4. Khuahun hang in Referee in khawluhai asak leh kikhawl ding hi.
 - Referees can postpone games due to inclement weather.
5. MASA Committee te neih Soccer ball bek zangthei ding.
 - Only soccer ball provided by the MASA Committee will be used.
6. Kimawlhun cingta makai te or referee te'n a zaksak khitciang mi a kim naikei leh minute 7 ki ngak lai ding a, tua khit teh player a om teng tawh ki pan ding hi. A kim lo teng a mi hong tun teh referee theih pih na tawh players 11 a cin dong lut kik thei ding hi.
 - Once the referee signals the start of the match, a team missing players will be given a 7-minute grace period. If the team still does not have all players present after 7 minutes, the match will begin with the available players. With referee approval, additional players may enter the field until the team reaches 11 players.
7. Minam dang mi 3 MASA committee phal na tawh ki lathei ki helthei ding hi. MASA committee in non-burmese a cih te pen: mikang, mivom, asian gam pan Japan, China, Korea, etc. Zo suan ta te zomi, mizo, kuki, mara, hakha, laimi, zotung, zophei, etc... koikoi ah a paing zong in burmese ah ki sim ding hi.
 - Each team may have up to 3 non-Burmese players. MASA considers non-Burmese players to include individuals of non-Burmese nationality or ethnicity, such as White, Black, or other Asian nationalities including Japanese, Chinese, Korean, etc. Individuals of Zo descent — including Mizo, Kuki, Mara, Hakha, Zotung, and related ethnic groups — will be considered Burmese regardless of their country of birth.
8. Mat lak dan ding a hih leh Group sungah a zo te mat 3 a ki dit leh mat khat tuak hi ding aa, a lel te'n mat ngah lo ding hi.
 - The winning team of each match will get 3 points, but if it's a tie, each team will get 1 point. Losing teams will not receive a point.
9. Game khat ah ki mawl hun ding pen, minute (...) hi ding aa, Minute (...) ta, nih vei ki mawl ding hi. A ki kal ah minute (...) sung tawl ngak hun om ding hi.
 - The duration for each game will be (...) minute, split into two (...) minute matches. The Half-time breaks in a match will be (...) long.
10. Group ki mawl na ah Point (Mat) ki bang a om leh Goal ngahzah, Goal piakzah, head-to-head, goal khum masa, a vek aa aki bat leh mee tawh khien sat ding (gentehna Head and Tail... Lu leh Paak). A hih kei leh Penalty zong hi thei ding hi.
 - If one group has the same amount of points, the winner will be decided by how many goals were scored by the other opponent and how many goals were conceded by the opponent team, head-to-head, and who scored first. If there is still a tie in points, there will be a penalty kick or a heads or tails coin flip.
11. Semi Final leh Final pen, minute (...) hi ding aa, minute (...) ta ki khien in ki mawl dg hi. A ki kal ah minute (...) ki tawl ngasak ding hi.
 - SEMI FINAL and Final matches will be (...) minutes in total, split into (...) minute matches and a 10-minute break during half time.
12. Semi Final leh Final a zo, alel, a ki theih cian kei leh, extra time 15-minute tuak ki pia ding a , kung ki laih pah in ki sui suak sak ding hi. A ki dit lai leh Penalty ki sui ding aa (5vs5), (1vs1). A ki dit lai leh penalty a pat na pan ki sui sak kik ding hi.
 - If there is a tie by the end of the semi and final matches, an additional 15 minutes will be added to the match while switching sides. If there is still a tie after 15 minutes, the match will move on to a penalty kick (5v5), (1v1). If there is still a draw in penalty kicks, the penalty kicks will restart.

13. Mi ki laih dan ding: Referee theih loh in, lut lo ding, pu suak thei lo ding, a om leh \$20 match commissioner kiang ah pia kha ding. Mi 7 bek gam khat ah ki laih thei ding hi.
 - The referee must be made aware of each substitution. Failure to let the referee know of a substitution will result in a \$20 fine to the match commissioner. Each team is ONLY allowed 7 substitutions per game.
14. Referee sem ding khen sat sa te ki laih nawn lo ding hi. Committee ten a hoih pen leh hun man tak in zat ding in na ki gen khin hi.
 - The on-duty referee assigned to the match will not be replaced, regardless of the circumstances. The Committees have ensured that these referees do their best and adhere to the time management guidelines.
15. Yellow card: \$20, Red Card: \$100 (migilo dal na hi. 2 yellow = red card hi pah aa, next game pen khawl kha ding hi. Final ah red card ngah ahih leh mai kum ah ki carry lo ding hi.)
 - Yellow card: \$20, Red card: \$100 (to prevent offenders). Receiving 2 Yellow cards = 1 Red Card and the player will forfeit the next game. Receiving a Red Card during the Final won't carry over to the next year.
16. Buai na khat peuh peuh a om leh, MASA Committee te khensat na ki zui ding hi.
 - If incidents occur, the MASA committee will review the matter, and their decision will be FINAL.
17. Tournament sung teng in, players te in, team khat bek ah sui thei ding aa, mi a ki la sim khawng a om leh, tua player te \$500 ki liau sak ding hi. A ki theih hun hun in, tua player te ki sui sak nawn lo ding hi.
 - Players can ONLY play on one team for the whole tournament. If players are found jumping to other teams, that player will be fined \$500 dollars and they will not be allowed to continue playing.
18. Injury waiver form pen sign loh peel mawh ding aa, kham theih guih theih a zang a om leh, a ki theih hunhun in red card tawh ki khawl sak ding hi. Uniform kibang sit set kul ding hi. Uniform ki bang lo te \$20 ki la ding hi. Zung bulh, Tau, Nai la khia ding. Ngai taak tuam, paa ham tang ding.
 - An Injury Waiver form must be signed, and using substances will result in an immediate Red Card. Uniforms MUST be identical, and non-complying players will be fined \$20 dollars. Accessory items such as rings, bracelets, watches, earrings, etc... MUST BE REMOVED. Shin Guards MUST be worn.

18.1 – No Refund Policy

All registration fees, entry fees, and any other payments made to the tournament are strictly non-refundable under any circumstances.

This includes but is not limited to:

- Team withdrawal before or during the tournament
- Player injury or unavailability
- Team disqualification due to rule violations
- Scheduling conflicts
- Personal or team-related emergencies
- Weather or major events beyond the organizer's control

18.2 – Acknowledgement

By submitting payment and registering for the tournament, all teams and their representatives confirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to this no-refund policy. No exceptions will be made regardless of the circumstances, and no appeals will be entertained.
